### 1 Organizing Authority

The Organizing Authority (OA) will be Amwaj Al Bahar Sport Equipment Rental LLC ("SeaYou").

### 2 Venue

Venue of the event will be on the beach located on top of the Palm Jebel Ali trunk, Dubai , see <http://bit.ly/sywc06>

### 3 Rules

Challenge will sail under current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ISAF and The Notice of Race.

### 4 Racing Area

The racing area will be 5 minutes sail away the launching area (top of the Palm Jebel Ali trunk).

### 5 Courses to be sailed

The courses to be sailed will be mentioned at the briefing.

### 6 Competing Classes & Equipment:

## 8 Eligibility and fees

The race entry is open to everyone. 1/3 of participants should be UAE national, 1/3 of participants should be female. Beginners are NOT accepted. Knowing how to swim is mandatory. Participants may enter by completing the form on <http://bit.ly/sywc06> no later than 20th October 2016 – 7pm.

Entrance fee: FREE for all participants and supporters.

### Charter equipment:

- SUP: no charter equipment.
- Kayak: no charter equipment.
- Windsurfing: AED 100 for the full event (StarBoard Phantom295 - board and complete rig 6.5sqm or 7.5sqm or 8.5sqm). There are only limited amount of charter equipment. Participants may charter by completing the form on <http://bit.ly/sywc06> no later than 20th October 2016 – 7pm.

## 9 Advertising

Equipment is required when requested to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

## 10 Safety

All competitors shall know how to swim. Life vest is mandatory for kayaking and windsurfing races. Life vest or leash is mandatory for all SUP races.

The competitor is entirely responsible for his own safety, whether afloat or ashore and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces these responsibilities. It is for the competitor to decide whether the boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which they find themselves. By launching or going to the sea, the competitor confirms that the boat is fit for those conditions and the crew is competent to sail and compete in them.
