Tournament rules

The tackle tournament will be held on Friday 24 November. Please consider it takes 45 min from Dubai Marina to reach the launching site on Palm Jebel Ali.

Planning:

- 5:15am: Meeting at the security gate
- 5:45am: briefing and safety procedures
- 6:00am: kayak Launch
- 10:30 all kayaks need to be back launch point
- 11:00am: all kayaks packed on the cars and all participants driving back to the event: all photos and video to be downloaded to O/A computers
- 12:00pm: prize giving

Please note:

- Bring your own kayak – no charter equipment available
- All kayaks brands are welcome
- Line must not exceed 15lb – 30lb
- Lures only
- No sabiki
- Lifevest is mandatory
- Bring your own camera with SD card

It is a Catch and Release tournament where videos—not fish—are submitted for scoring. Number of fishes caught, not weight and length, determines the winners. A Picture of the fish on the kayak as well as a video of the fish being released is mandatory to ensure a level playing field.

Scoring system:

- Kingfish: 20 points
- Hammour: 20 points
- Barracuda: 10 points
- Sweetlips : 10 points
- Silver grunt : 10 points
- Travelly : 7 points
- Other fish: 3 points

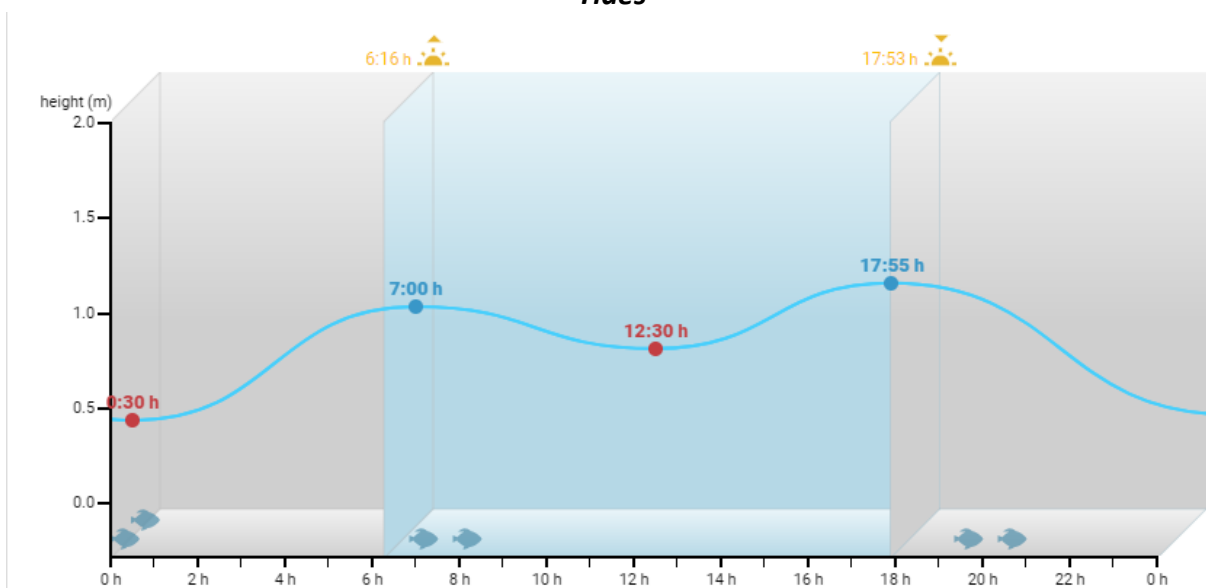
- Biggest Catch of the day
